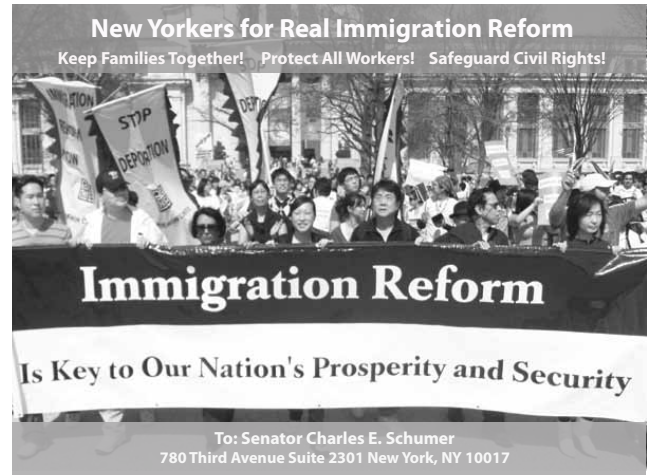


First We Marched, Then We Voted, Now We Demand **REAL IMMIGRATION REFORM!**
